





This is a beautiful, symbolic ritual for honouring memory, expressing grief, and creating a shared, living tribute.

Friends and family contribute individual blooms representing their unique relationship/love adding to a collective arrangement, symbolising unity, the flow of life and memory, and transforming personal sadness into community support and beauty, often signifying release and ongoing remembrance rather than a final goodbye.

Our individual flowers become one beautiful growing arrangement, reflecting our shared love for Gayle.

Flowers embody beauty, growth, and eventual wilting, mirroring life and death.

The act can be a gentle way to “let go” or transition grief into a visual memory.
