Just look for me and love me, and I'll be close to you.

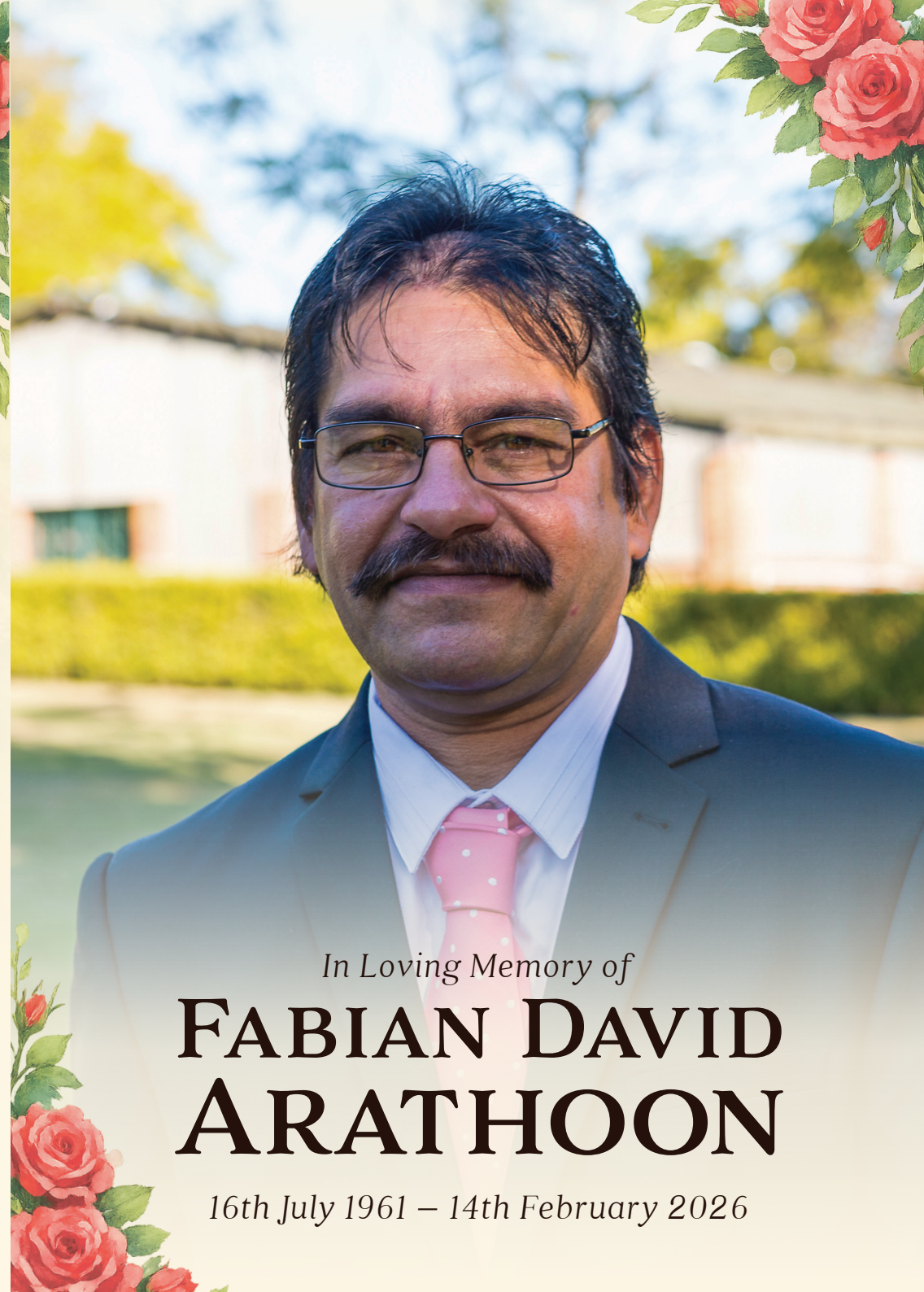
It won't be forever, the day will come and then
